Inscape's Middle School Curriculum Termly Overview

English

This half term we will be studying the text: The Crucible it is designed to develop students' critical thinking, analytical, and communication skills through an in-depth study of Arthur Miller's The Crucible. The unit encourages students to explore complex themes such as hysteria, power, reputation, and justice, linking these to historical and contemporary contexts. Students will examine Miller's language, character development, and stagecraft to understand how he critiques societal flaws and human behaviour. Through speaking and listening activities, performances, and essay writing, students will enhance their ability to articulate ideas, empathize with diverse perspectives, and engage with challenging texts.

Science

In science this half term middle school will be learning about Forces. We will be looking at what forces do, the different types of forces, how we measure forces, using arrow forces, balanced and unbalanced forces, friction and energy transfer. We will be doing through a mixture of practical and theory lessons.
